ECLIPSE PARENTS CODE OF CONDUCT

Parents' Code of Conduct:

- A. I understand that by participating in Evergreen Park Eclipse my daughter must also participate in the EPGSL in-house program.
- B. I understand that Eclipse games/practices must not interfere with in-house practice/games. When there is a conflict, in-house always comes first. The only exception is that a player may participate in an Eclipse game/tournament over an in-house practice.
- C. I understand that I must report to my daughter's manager immediately any injury occurring during the course of an Eclipse practice, game, or Eclipse event.
- D. Parents and their guests are expected to be courteous and civil and to always display the best example of good sportsmanship at all Eclipse games, tournaments, practices and functions.
- E. Foul, abusive, and disruptive language or any other disruptive action directed toward a manager, coach, player, umpire, or spectator, whether on the same team or another team, will not be tolerated.
- F. No manager or coach shall make disparaging comments about other managers, coaches, players, parents, fans or umpires on social media.

I understand that any failure on my part to comply with the above Code of Conduct will result in my being asked to leave the game, practice or event or under extreme circumstances, removal of my daughter from the Eclipse program.
